

### DIRECTIONS from the A1 highway/Orvieto (25 minutes)

- Exit the A1 highway at **Orvieto**. Turn right into Orvieto.
- After 1.1 kilometers, you'll come to a round-about. Exit the round-about at the 11:00 spoke. You'll go through an underpass and through an intersection with a traffic light that is usually not operating. Almost immediately after the light, veer left before the petrol station. (If you go straight, you end up at the train station.)
- Very shortly, you'll come to a fork in the road. The road you're on will veer left, but you should take **the right fork toward Allerona**.
- Follow this winding road to the town of **Sferracavallo**. At the roundabout in the centre of town, turn right (3:00 spoke).
- 200-300 meters later, **turn left** before the petrol station in the direction of **Castel Viscardo**.
- At the 4-kilometer mark, on the right, you'll see a **small sign for Viceno**. (**Watch carefully because it's easy to miss**.) Turn **left** toward **Viceno**. This winding road will take you through the small town of Viceno. Follow the main road through the town. The road will wind up and through a small forest and eventually will level out.
- A couple of kilometres beyond Viceno, you'll come to a roundabout. **Turn left (9:00 spoke)** in the direction of **Acquapendente**. (You'll no longer follow signs for Castel Viscardo.)
- 1.2 kilometers later, turn right, toward **Acquapendente**.
- A couple of kilometers later, you'll see Torre Alfina (castle) ahead of you, but **don't go straight**. **Follow the main road in its sweeping left turn**.
- About 500 meters later, you'll see a stone farmhouse with a tower on your right. That's us!
- Keep going straight for 200 meters: there is a red mail box and beautiful oak trees at the entrance to our drive.

### Directions from the Cassia (RR#2)/ ACQUAPENDENTE (5 minutes):

- The Cassia (RR#2) runs north-south through Acquapendente. At the south end of town, opposite some rather unattractive modern apartments, take the **turnoff for Torre Alfina** onto the Torre Alfina provincial road. (If you're coming from the north, turn left. If you're coming from the south, turn right.)

At the 7 kilometer mark, you will see a stone farmhouse with a tower on your left. That's us! There's a red mail box and beautiful oak trees at the entrance to our drive.
